The CVS – College Visit System

IMPROPER COLLEGE SELECTION will ultimately contribute to student dissatisfaction as well as lowered performance. Both of these factors easily translate into lost time and money. Dissatisfaction that leads to a transfer may add a year or more to the pursuit of a degree.

The use of a structured approach to college selection can potentially eliminate the risk of a full additional quarter, semester or year of college. Even using a modest Cost of Attendance, savings could easily range from \$5,000 to \$25,000 or more.

The true objective of the college visit should be to determine how well a particular college satisfies the student's criteria. The CVS system was constructed to provide the student with specific guidelines in formulating a numerical score sheet for every college visit.

Knowing that one school scored 3950 and another came in at 2850 could make the difference in a quality decision.

While we believe college selection should combine elements of nostalgia, familiarity, budget and passion, there are arguably many more criteria that must be included in the evaluation process to ensure an outcome that will stand the test of time (at least enough time to get the degree within the prescribed timeframe).

The CVS system provides a method for the student to score every college visit consistently, with their own prioritized criteria.
